Omaha Open Rules

Scratch. The Teen Masters Omaha Open is a scratch singles event.

Divisions. The 2022 Omaha Open offers singles competition in separate girls and boys divisions.

Eligibility. To participate you must be 19 or younger on August 5, 2022, and an amateur bowler.

Omaha Open Format.

- Check-in opens at 10:15 AM, practice begins at 11:00 AM.
- Bowlers will roll six games across six pairs of lanes on a challenging oil pattern using any USBC-approved ball.
- Based on six-game pinfall, the top eight girl and eight boys will be seeded into separate single-elimination brackets.
- Ties that impact advancement will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.

Entry Fees. The online entry fee is \$75. Walk-ins must pay \$80 in cash.

Dress Code. With enhanced competition comes enhanced dress & conduct guidelines. Collared shirt/jersey is required. Name on back is encouraged, but is not required. Slacks, khakis, skirts/skorts are allowed. Skirts must be at least fingertip length. Denim, shorts, sweats, spandex, yoga pants, headgear, sunglasses, and electronics are prohibited. Any requests for exceptions must be accompanied by medical documentation and approved by tournament management.

No Extreme Lofting. Lofting the ball past the arrows is not allowed. A competitor who intentionally lofts the ball past the arrows will receive one warning. Subsequent lofts past the arrows will result in zero pinfall and/or disqualification.

Sportsmanship & Mutual Respect. Competitors, family members, coaches, and spectators will display good sportsmanship and mutual respect at all times. Those failing to do so will be asked to leave Omaha Bowl.

Scholarships & Championship Invitations. The top girl and top boy are each guaranteed a paid entry into the 2022 Teen Masters North American Championships in Detroit, Michigan. SMART scholarships will be awarded on a 1:8 ratio. Should the winning girl or boy be unable to participate in the Championships or already possess an entry into the Championships, the entry will be awarded to the next eligible bowler. The Championships entries are not transferable and have no cash value.

Publicity Release. By participating in the Omaha Open, the bowler and his/her parents/guardians acknowledge Teen Masters' right to make use of and to permit others to make use of bowler's name, scores, voice, pictures, photographs and other likeness for any purpose in any manner related to the advertising, broadcast, publication or promotion of Teen Masters.

Authority. Nebraska Youth Bowling Partnership tournament managers and Killer 'B' Promotions will determine any matters not covered in these rules.
